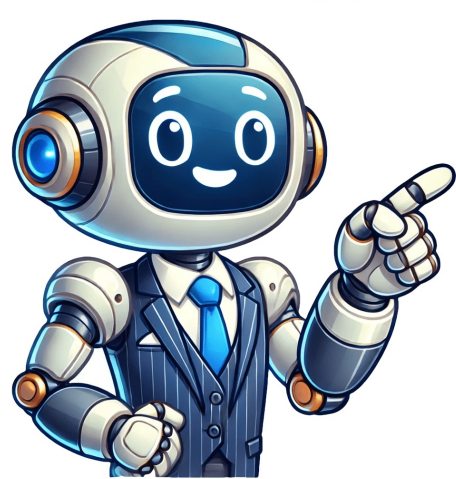

No, Tangled isn't exactly a musical available on Broadway. Still, there is a stage production of this Disney animated classic featuring original music by Alan Menken. Now, it's available for streaming on Disney's YouTube channel. A number of Disney animated movies have been transformed into stage productions, from Beauty and the Beast and The Little Mermaid, to shows currently on Broadway like Aladdin and The Lion King. On Disney cruises, fans can even see a stage version of Tangled. This musical features much of the same story as the animated film. In it, Rapunzel risks everything to follow her dream of seeing floating lanterns in the nearby kingdom. She's joined on this adventure by the wanted thief named Flynn Rider and her trusty sidekick, a chameleon named Pascal. Alan Menken, is also the mastermind behind the original music for Tangled and the song When Will My Life Begin. Rapunzel had been around for a long time, and I had no idea it was going to come my way. I think we had just finished Enchanted and I had done Shaggy Dog and we were developing a few things, and then the call came, Alan Menken said of the original animated movie, according to Collider. They wanted to talk about Rapunzel, so then we started taking meetings and talking, and then I brought Glenn Slater on, he continued. Once we started, they really wanted to get this out fast. So the songs were all basically written in under a year. Many song choices and then they were storyboarded. The last song to get written was the Incantation which runs throughout the movie. The first one that was written was When Will My Life Begin. Presumably, Tangled will remain a Disney cruise exclusive production. That means if you want to see this musical, your best bet is watching the virtual viewing. This is an hour long video posted to YouTube, sharing the entire production to Disney fans worldwide. This wouldn't be the first production Disney posted to their YouTube channel. Due to the closing of the Disney parks and the Disney cruise line, the company posted peeks into the magic. That includes a recording of the Magic Kingdom night show, Happily Ever After and the new Disneyland parade Magic Happens. Disney princess movies, including The Little Mermaid, Tangled, Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs, and Beauty and the Beast are available for binge-watching on Disney+. Disney+ will offer Premier Access to Mulan for \$29.99 on disneyplus.com and select platforms such as Roku. Tangled: The Musical is a Broadway-style show based off the 2010 Walt Disney Animation Studios feature film, Tangled. It is performed exclusively aboard the Disney cruise ship, Disney Magic. The show serves as a live-action musical adaptation of the original animated film and features three brand new songs, "When She Returns", "Flower of Gold", and "Wanted Man", as well as new reprises to songs from the film. These songs are from the Academy-Award winning composer Alan Menken and lyricist Glenn Slater, who also wrote and composed the original music of Tangled. Following a recent report from the Hollywood Reporter that a developmental workshop of Tangled is underway, BroadwayWorld can confirm that Disney Theatrical Group is indeed exploring a stage version of the 2010 animated film. Whether the show will eventually land on Broadway remains to be seen, as Disney Theatrical often makes titles available strictly for professional licensing and schools, and future plans for the adaptation have not yet been announced. Tangled is loosely based on the German fairy tale Rapunzel in the collection of folktales published by the Brothers Grimm. Featuring the voices of Mandy Moore, Zachary Levi, and Donna Murphy, it tells the story of Rapunzel, a lost young princess with magical long blonde hair who yearns to leave her secluded tower. She accepts the aid of an intruder to take her out into the world which she has never seen. The film featured music by Alan Menken and lyrics by Glenn Slater, who have also collaborated on the stage versions of The Little Mermaid and Sister Act, as well as the television series Galavant. Watch Tangled on Disney Cruise Line: An abridged stage adaptation titled Tangled: The Musical premiered on board the Disney Magic of the Disney Cruise Line 2015, featuring three new songs written by Alan Menken and Glenn Slater. A short film, Tangled Ever After, was released in 2012, and a television series, Tangled: Before Ever After, premiered in 2017, serving as an introduction to a continuing television series, Tangled: The Series (later renamed Rapunzel's Tangled Adventure), that started airing on Disney Channel on March 24, 2017.
