Be careful about exaggeration While applicants need to promote themselves, there's a difference between selling yourself and going over the top. Don't just list your accomplishments and skills. Link anything you mention to aspects of the course you are applying for. 6. Check the text for consistency Always try to keep a consistent flow throughout the body of the letter, and don't leave any details that seem out of place or irrelevant. If phrases or claims stand out, it gives the impression they have been forced into the text, and admissions staff may suspect that applicants are exaggerating. 7. How do you end a motivational letter? The ending is almost as important as the introduction. Ideally, it will briefly summarize your reasons for studying and express your hope to be considered. Don't make a joke to close the letter. Just be polite and clear about your desire to study. 8. Be disciplined about proofreading After you've written the first draft, it's essential to check the text for errors. Any spelling or grammar errors could prove fatal for your application and should be removed immediately. At this stage, cross-reference the course requirements with your text to ensure you've covered every aspect. 9. Give yourself the time you need to write a great letter When writing a motivational letter, don't leave it until close to the application deadline. Instead, make it one of the first things you do. That way, you can leave it for a few days and revisit the text. In that time, new ideas could have occurred to you, and they could be what makes your letter exceptional. 10. Keep these basics in mind Finally, try to follow these basic structural themes when putting your letter together. There are no rules about length, but 2 pages are about right. Use an introduction to set a positive tone, the main body to set out what makes you a suitable candidate, and what attracts you to the course, and the conclusion to round things off.
