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Like other ablative lasers, the CoolPeel renews skin by quickly heating water molecules in the skins deeper layers, which triggers the bodys natural healing response and stimulates collagen production.Unlike most ablative lasers, which remove the superficial layer of skin tissue and usually entail a week or two of downtime, the CoolPeel laser delivers high energy in a super-short pulse that creates controlled injury to the dermis with less lingering heat in the surrounding skin, which is where it gets its name. This means less flaking, peeling, and swelling afterward.The SmartXide Tetra CO2 laser gives CoolPeel providers the ability to tailor the laser power and pulse size to the patient's age and skin concerns. Customizable pulse size also means that they can treat smaller areas, such as around the eyes.In addition to extremely short pulse times that prevent thermal damage to skin, the laser also has a unique spray pattern that shortens the overall treatment time. It takes just 5 to 15 minutes to complete a full treatment on the face, while other ablative laser treatments can take up to two hours, depending on the size of the treatment area.Some providers recommend combining a laser peel with radiofrequency microneedling treatments, like Vivace, to maximize the boost of new collagen formation and create new, healthy cells.RealSelf Tip: Theres also a chemical peel that goes by the name Cool Peel. A type of fractional CO2 laser, it cools the surface of the skin before vaporizing skin cells with pulses of intense light.Its a fractional laser treatment, which means that it actually targets only a portion of the skin's surface, while also heating up water molecules in the lower layer, to trigger cell repair through a healing response that boosts collagen and elastin production.This in-office cosmetic dermatology procedure takes about 15 minutes. Depending on the severity of the skin concerns youre targeting, you may need more than one treatment session.Awareness of Coolaser has increased as celebrities, like Kim Kardashian, have raved about their results.The official Coolaser treatment is available only at the Beverly Hills, California, clinic of Dr. Simon Ourian.
