

To combat moisture issues in your home, consider installing exhaust fans, dehumidifiers, or using moisture-absorbing products like DampRid Refillable Moisture Absorbers. Placing oscillating fans strategically can also enhance ventilation. Additionally, use open shelving units or plastic containers for storage to prevent moisture buildup. Repainting problem areas with mould-resistant paint and applying a mildew inhibitor like Protite Mould Defender can help protect against mould growth. Using plants that absorb moisture, such as peace lilies or spider plants, and regularly maintaining gutters can also contribute to reducing dampness in your home. Hardwoods come from flowering trees such as eucalyptus and are more naturally durable, stronger, and denser timbers. They can be heavy and harder to work with than softwoods like pine. For example, Merbau decking is a softwood. The use of timber in construction projects such as decks, house flooring, and cantilevered balconies requires proper classification and rating to ensure safety and structural integrity. There are two primary rating scales: F for hardwoods and MGP (machine-graded Pine) for Pine, with different ratings indicating varying levels of strength and durability. For example, MGP10 is suitable for general use in building work and framing of walls, while MGP12 is recommended for more heavy-duty applications such as framing of walls and some floor joists. In contrast, F ratings range from F1 (weakest timbers, such as LVL (Laminated Veneer Lumber), are increasingly used due to their consistency in smoothness, strength, and other properties. These engineered timbers can be produced in long spans that would be difficult or impossible with natural timbers, finger jointed timber, medium-density fibreboard (MDF), and particle board. MDF is often used for shelves, cabinets, door panels, and other decorative elements, while particle board is commonly found in kitchen cabinets and flat-pack furniture. For clogged drains, a combination of methods can be employed to clear the blockage. This may involve breaking up debris, pushing the blockage through the drain using a plunger or snake, and dissolving any remaining blockages with enzyme drain cleaner.
