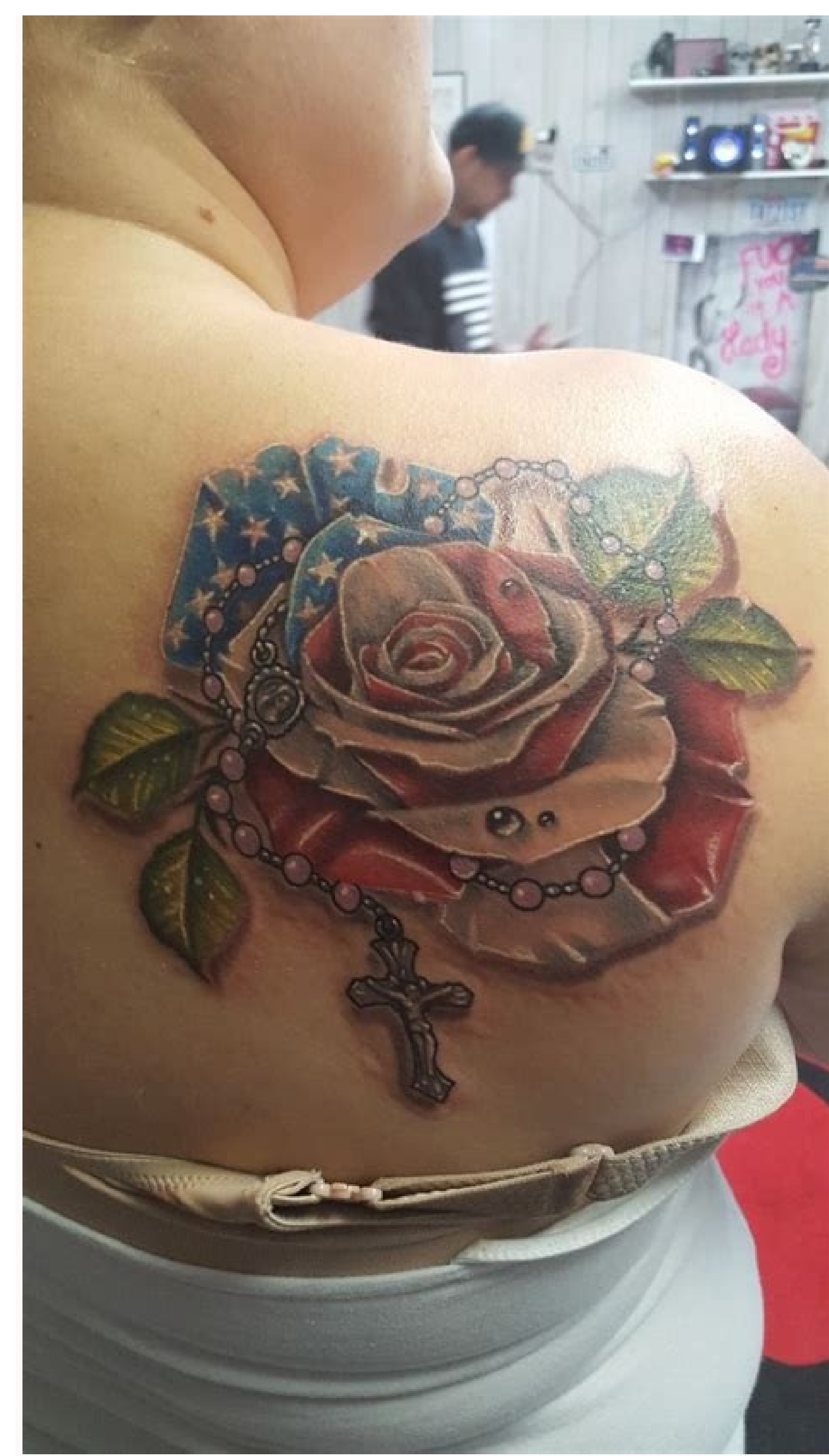

Their sound is hard rock mixed with blues influences, with songs like "Bad Boy for Love", "Rock 'n' Roll Outlaw", "Nice Boys", "We Can't Be Beaten", and Scarred for Life. Their first four albums were produced by Harry Wanda and George Young, who also worked with AC/DC. They broke up in 1987 and reunited briefly in 1993 to tour Guns N' Roses in Australia They reunited in 1998 and have since released two more studio albums According to Australian rock historian Ian McFarlane, Rose Tattoo are "one of the most recognizable bands of all time for tight lyricism." Guns N' Roses, L.A. Guns, Keel, Nashville Pussy, Motosierra, Pud Spuke, Helen Schneider, Skrewdriver and the Uruguayan band Knight's Night have covered songs by Rose Tattoo. On 16 August 2006 they were inducted into the Australian Recording Industry Association (ARIA) Hall of Fame. Seven former members have died, including four members of the early recording group Dallas Royal (1991), Peter Wells (2006), Jan Rylan (2006), Lobie Lloyd (2007), Mick Coke (2009), Neil Smith (2013) and John Mayer (2020) History Early years (1976-1977) Main articles: Buffalo (band) and Band of Light Rose Tattoo formed in Sydney in 1976 with Leigh Johnston on rhythm guitar, Tony Lake on vocals and led by slide guitarist Peter Wells, who started out as a bassist for the heavy metal band Buffalo.The composition was supplemented by Michael Vanderslui, Jan Raylen from Band of Light joined us on bass. He learned to play in prison and gave the Wells band the street recognition he had been waiting for. Johnston was soon replaced by rhythm guitarist Mick Cox; Lake and Vanderslui were replaced by former members Buster Brown, Angry Anderson and Dallas "Digger" Royall, respectively. Buster Brown from Melbourne played at the 1974 Sunbury Festival, which also featured future AC/DC drummer Phil Rudd. Rose Tattoo performed at the local rock club Checkers on New Year's Eve. The Rolling Stones, Faces and Billy Thorpe and his 70s-inspired sound Rose Tattoo quickly gained a following in the Sydney area. The members of AC/DC were fans and recommended them to their label Albert Productions. The



group's debut single "Bad Boy for Love" was written by Rylen, who had left the (non-LA) punk rock band X prior to its release in October 1977. "Bad Boy for Love" was produced by Wanda & Young (former producers of The Easybeats, AC/DC) and peaked at number 19 on the Australian Kent Music Review Singles Chart. The Roosters initially switched to bass to reflect Rylen's departure, then Chris Turner (ex-Buffalo) joined. The band toured the country in pub rock, competing against the Angels, Cold Chisel, Dragon and Kevin Borich Express. Debut albums, successes and subsequent albums (1978–1992)
Geordie Leach, former bassist for Buster Brown, was hired to record their debut album, *Rose Tattoo*, which reached the top 40 of the Australian Kent Music Report. List of albums, November 1978 [6]
Produced by Wanda & Young, the album was released in some markets as *Rock N' Roll Outlaw* after their second single "Rock N' Roll Outlaw" failed to reach the top 50. Leach left the band in May 1979 and was replaced in October by guitarist Loby Lloyd on bass,balls, purple hearts, wild cherries). During his short tenure, they recorded "Legalise Realise", which was released as an independent split in March 1980, the second song "Bong on Aussie" was recorded by country singer Colin Patterson to promote the campaign to legalize marijuana. ] They toured the US and then Europe (including the UK) later in 1980, but in September Lloyd left and Leach returned. In early 1981, "Rock N' Roll Outlaw" began to gain success in Europe, reaching No. 2 in France, No. 5 in Germany and No. 60 in the UK. Anderson, Cocks, Leach, Royall and Wells toured Europe from April. Three years after their debut, the band released their next album, *Assault and Battery*, in September, which reached the Australian Top 30. Both *Rock n' Roll Outlaw* and *Assault and Battery* reached number one in the UK Heavy Metal Albums Chart. In 1981, *Rose Tattoo's* European tour included a performance at the Reading Festival, where Anderson repeatedly hit amps until his scalp bled. They were hailed as the loudest band to play London's Marquee since Led Zeppelin. Back in Australia, the band began work on their third album; Young guitarist Robin Riley replaced Cocks, who later joined Heaven, in 1982 they released *Scarred for Life* and then toured the US supporting Aerosmith and ZZ Top. The band's US tour was not very successful, but proved influential in the LA underground sleaze metal scene with bands such as Guns N' Roses, later *Rose Tattoo* as favorites and a live recording of Nice Boys! @ Like suicide in 1986.[1]
Southern Stars and Beats from a Single Drum (1983-1986)
In 1983, after an American tour, Riley, Royal and Wells left. The remaining duo of Anderson and Leach recruited guitarists Greg Jordan and John Mayer from Perth progressive metal band Saracen. Together with drummer Scott Johnston (Jimmy and the Boys, Outline in the Kitchen, Flash in the Pan, Swannee, Peter Wells) the band recorded 1984's *Southern Stars*, their last album for Albert Productions with producers Wanda & Young. Leach then left to join Cox, Rylen, Royall and Wells in *Illustrated Men* which toured from 1984 to 1985. Anderson found time to play the character "Ironbar" Bassey in the 1985 film *Mad Max Beyond Thunderdome*. That same year, *Rose Tattoo*, consisting of Anderson, Johnston, Meyer, Andy Schicone (bass) and Tim Gaze (slide guitar), released a cover of Steppenwolf's "Born to be Wild", their first release on Mushroom Records. Meyer left and the band recorded 1986's *Beats from a Single Drum* as four tracks for Mushroom. Soon after, Anderson launched a solo career, and the band broke up in late 1987. The album was then re-released as Anderson's first solo album, with the ballad "Suddenly" as his debut solo single. However, Anderson admitted to regretting recording a pop/ballad oriented album. [edit] "Suddenly" wasn't much of a chart success until it was used on the television soap opera *Neighbors* at the wedding of Scott Robinson (Jason Donovan) and Charlene. Mitchell (Kylie Minogue). "Suddenly" reached No. 2 in September 1987 after being held back from No. 1 by Minogue's own debut single "Locomotion". Side projects and temporary makeovers (1988–1997)

In the early 1990s, Anderson attempted to reunite *Rose Tattoo*, but Dallas Royal died of cancer in 1991 while undergoing treatment for heroin addiction and alcoholism, delaying this transformation. Anderson explained to Nick Milligan in March 2011, "I was in Los Angeles in 1989 recording an album that came out with the single 'Bound for Glory,' under the influence. Then I realized that apart from who I wasTo establish themselves as a singer-songwriter, the group still had a large following. I called the other members and said, "Let's reform." We're three years or more apart. It was long enough to settle our differences and heal all our wounds. I called all the original members who were still interested and they all said, "Yes, we'll meet." So I said we should negotiate a deal where the band could come to Los Angeles and record. But of course it was the year our original drummer "Digger" Royall quit his heroin addiction. Unfortunately, while he was recovering from methadone, cancer exploded in his body. That was ironic because the cancer was suppressed by heroin addiction. He was dead within months. On a personal level, it shook the team so much because we were so excited about the reform. We didn't reform until 1992. [This quote must be quoted]"
*Rose Tattoo* supported Guns N' Roses on the Australian leg of their *Use Your Illusion Tour*. Anderson, Wells, Cocks and Leach were joined by new drummer Paul DeMarco from Wells' solo band, who reunited for a 1993 tour. The reunion was short-lived as everyone returned to solo projects. Around this time, some former members of *Rose Tattoo* formed a short-lived band with former Candy Harlots singer Aiz Lynch. The group had many rehearsals but only recorded one demo before disbanding. The Second Reformation: Pain for Blood Brothers (1998–2010)
*Rose Tattoo*, with original bassist Ian Rilen replacing Leach, reformed again in 1998 for "All Hell Breaks". The *Loose Tour!*! Rilen only stayed with the band for the duration of this tour. Leach returned to the band the following year, although Steve King took his place in 2000. Rock music historian Ian McFarlane wrote that they are "one of the most respected bands of all time. The Tatts played incomparable street-heavy blues with an emphasis on slide guitar and sharp lyrical statements.Australian rock and pop.[1]
*Rose Tattoo* has since toured regularly throughout Australia and Europe. In 2000, the band performed at the Wacken Open Air Festival as part of their tour. These shows formed the basis of the live album *25 to Life*. The group performed five songs at the Gimme Ted benefit concert on March 10, 2001. In 2002, Pain, the group's first studio album in 16 years, was released. Cocks rejoined the group and they were preparing material for a future album. Plans for their next *Blood Brothers* album were disrupted when Wells died on March 27, 2006, four years after being diagnosed with prostate cancer. On 16 August, *Rose Tattoo* was inducted into the Australian Recording Industry Association (ARIA) Hall of Fame by musician Sarah McLeod alongside former Lobby member Lloyd and Daddy Cool, Divinyls, Icehouse and Helen Reddy. Anderson informed Wells of the impending subpoena: "He was pleased. I was very pleased, to know about it. It's good to be recognized for the music we need to improve." [13]
Founding member Ian Rilen died of bladder cancer on 30 October. One of his last public appearances was during the Hall of Fame induction. *Rose Tattoo* at Meredith Festival 2006
Also in October, several *Rose Tattoo* songs were voted for and included in the Triple M Essential 2006 Countdown of Songs, including "Bad Boy for Love" (voted #1060 in 2006) and "We Can defeat" (397th vote in 2006). That month they were one of 55 acts selected to play at Triple J's 2006 Impossible Music Festival with a live recording of a 1980 New Year's Eve performance at Mount Druitt in New South Wales, selected from over 1,000 Live at Wireless Recordings. from around the world. 31-year history of the station. On April 21, 2007, Lobby Loyde died at the age of 65, two years after being diagnosed with lung cancer. In June, *Rose Tattoo* and Sebastian supported Guns N' Resosen the Australian leg of their China Democracy tour. In October they supported Motörhead on their Australian tour. In an interview with Australian rock magazine *Unbelievably Bad*, Anderson announced his intention to retire after another album. In 2008, they played at the Download Festival in England.[16]
In April 2009, it was announced that guitarist Mick Cox was suffering from liver cancer and died on 22 December. By 2010, five former members had died of various types of cancer: Dallas Royals (throat cancer in 1991), Peter Wells (prostate cancer in 2006), Jan Reelen (bladder cancer in 2006), Lobie Lloyd (lung cancer, in 2007) and Mick Rooster. (Liver Cancer, 2009).
Outlaws Closing Statement (2011-present)
*Rose Tattoo* celebrated its 35th anniversary in 2011. They were demo songs for a proposed new album, and Anderson told Milligan that this would be "the band's final announcement", but it didn't happen. They weren't sure whether to proceed or not when DeMarco was arrested in September 2014: He pleaded guilty to gun crimes and was sentenced to at least six years in prison. On August 5, 2017, Anderson, Dee Pritchard, Bob Spencer, Mark Evans and John "Watto" Watson announced the new line-up. In August 2018, new drummer Jackie Barnes, son of Australian singer Jimmy Barnes, joined the band. In March 2020, the band toured Europe with Justin Ngariki on drums. This month they released their new album *Outlaws* on Cleopatra Records. In May 2020, they were scheduled to tour the US for the first time since 1982, but the tour was delayed due to restrictions due to COVID-19.
Outlaws is a re-recording of *Rose Tattoo's* debut album and three early songs not included on the 1978 releases: "Snow Queen", "Sweet Love (Rock n Roll)" and "Rosetta". Anderson stated the reasons behind the album: "Honoring the past and respecting the future." It was recorded at Hercules Studios in Sydney by Mark Opitt and Tim McCartney. It was produced and mixed by Opitz/Spencer and McCartney. The insert notes were written by author Murray Englehart.[23]
On September 1, 2020, *Rose Tattoo* announced on social media the death of John Mayer, the band's slide guitarist from 1983 to 1985. After 16 years of faithful service, Dai Pritchard announced his departure from *Rose Tattoo* via Facebook on April 14, 2021, leaving the group amicably to pursue a new career in mental health. When the band resumed live performances in 2022, Paul DeMarco returned to drums and Mick Arnold took over slide guitar duties. After 5 years of faithful service, Bob Spencer announced his departure from the band on September 18, 2022 via Facebook.
