When is twilight midnight sun coming out in cinema

This morning, Twilight author Stephenie Meyer announced that the long-awaited book Midnight Sun would finally arrive on August 4th. Midnight Sun has had a dramatic history with parts of the uncompleted novel being leaked online in 2008. The book follows the events of Twilight but from Edward's perspective. Meyer made the draft of the twelve leaked chapters available on her website, but felt that, "'If I tried to write Midnight Sun now, in my current frame of mind, James would probably win and all the Cullens would die, which wouldn't dovetail too well with the original story. In any case, I feel too sad about what has happened to continue working on Midnight Sun, and so it is on hold indefinitely.'" Now that hold is off and the book will be released later this year. We typically don't cover book releases on Collider, but the release of Midnight Sun now raises the question of what happens with the Twilight film franchise. Love it or hate it, Twilight was a massive hit and the last movie in the series, The Twilight Saga: Breaking Dawn - Part 2 earned \$829 million worldwide. Lionsgate obviously wants another bite of this apple, and I imagine deals are going down behind the scenes to work on an adaptation of Midnight Sun. That being said, if Midnight Sun does happen (and I imagine there's too much money at stake for it to lay dormant), we should be prepared for recasting. It is a retelling of the events of Twilight from the perspective of Edward Cullen as opposed to that of Bella Swan. It started as a simple character exercise, with a single chapter from Edward's perspective, but she came to realize she had to do the whole book.[2] Meyer has stated that Twilight is the only possible book from the series that she plans to rewrite from Edward's perspective.[3] To give them a better feel of Edward's character, Meyer allowed Catherine Hardwicke, the director of the film adaptation of Twilight, and Robert Pattinson, the actor who plays Edward, to read some completed chapters of the novel while they were filming the movie. Pre-release history[] As of August 28, 2008, the release date of the book has been postponed indefinitely and it is not certain that it will be published. Meyer halted the writing of Midnight Sun after the illegal leak of 12 chapters of the unfinished manuscript on the Internet. She stated, "If I tried to write Midnight Sun now, in my current frame of mind, James would probably win and all the Cullens would die, which wouldn't dovetail too well with the original story. In any case, I feel too sad about what has happened to continue working on Midnight Sun, and so it is on hold indefinitely." Meyer does plan to publish the book, because she believes Edward deserves to have his version of the story.[2] Meyer later slightly recanted the statement that appeared on her website, telling EW "That was a joke! And it sounded so serious amidst all the lawyer talk and I think my fans thought, wow, she's threatening to kill everyone! [Laughing.] I felt kind of bad about that. I never felt any anger, actually. Just a lot of sadness. I mean it was a sucker punch — like someone came up behind you and just hammered you in the kidneys and you had no idea it was coming."[5] She has made the leaked chapters available on her website in fairness to her readers, now that the novel has been compromised before its intended publication date. In a recent interview done with EW, Meyer has stated that, "So my goal is to go for, like, I don't know, two years without ever hearing the words Midnight Sun. And once I'm pretty sure that everyone's forgotten about it, I think I'll be able to get to the place where I'm alone with it again. Then I'll be able to sneak in and work on it again."[6] This statement jokingly lead to the creation of a nickname for Midnight Sun, created at the Twilight Lexicon: Dark High Noon, in an attempt to still be able to talk about Midnight Sun, but not mention its name directly. Cover[] Working cover The cover prior to the release was that of a red sun fading in the horizon. The released cover is that of a cut pomegranate with seeds spilling outwards. Like the apple of Twilight, pomegranate seeds carry significance to how Bella is pulled into the supernatural world. The pomegranate represents Hades entrapping Persephone in the underworld after consuming one seed. References[] The Twilight Saga is returning to the public conscious this week, as Stephenie Meyer is releasing Midnight Sun next week. The novel, which comes out on August 4, tells the story of the first book but from the perspective of Edward Cullen.
